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## Saudi Arabia nationalises four jobs in retail sector

### Expats off car showrooms, garment stores, furniture shops, kitchenware shops

Saudi Arabia's Ministry of Labour and Social Development said it would start nationalising four of 12 jobs in the retail sector. The ministry said the Saudisation of jobs will cover car and motorbike showrooms, readymade and children garments, home and office furniture shops and shops selling kitchenware.

Saudi Arabia has increased up its efforts to replace 60,000 expatriates with nationals before January 2019 by mounting an aggressive 'Saudisation' campaign. The ministry has announced the gradual plan to restrict employment in 12 sectors to Saudi nationals over three phases, the first of which to begin this month.

The nationalisation of jobs in shops selling watches, eyeglasses and electric and electronic appliances will start on



November 10. The Saudisation of jobs in shops selling medical equipment, building material, car spare parts, carpets and confectionaries will begin on January 8, 2019. The ministry said the decision was taken with a view

to providing more jobs to Saudi men and women.

Inspectors from the ministry have started the first phase by monitoring the implementation of the 'Saudisation' in car and motorbike showrooms, shops

selling readymade garments for men and children, home and office furniture shops and shops selling kitchenware, local media reported. However, the lack of skilled Saudi labour remains a challenge.

The plan aims at reducing unemployment among Saudis, currently standing at 12.8 per cent, and reduce the public sector wage bill by bolstering private sector employment. Under the reform agenda spearheaded by crown prince Mohammed bin Salman, the government seeks to reduce unemployment to seven per cent by 2030.

The Kingdom aims to reach a 70 per cent 'Saudisation' level in these four sectors. However, the country is facing a hiring crisis. In response to the new restrictions, many shops have either closed business or reduced their number of branches, due to the higher costs of employing Saudis and the lack of skilled labour. Foreigners occupy approximately 70.5 per cent of jobs in wholesale shops, according to the General Authority for Statistics.

At least one million foreign workers will leave their jobs over the coming three months, and

## Expats occupy 70% of jobs in wholesale shops

THE expatriates are in control of about 70.5 per cent of jobs in wholesale shops, business daily *Al-Eqtisadiyah* reported quoting a report by the General Authority for Statistics (GaStat). There were a total of 2,41,076 employees working in the wholesale business involving 36,379 establishments by the first quar-

ter of 2018.

The report said, there were 1,70,027 expatriates involved in the wholesale business against 71,050 Saudis constituting about 29.5 per cent of the total number of workers.

GaStat said, male workers were 2,38,251 constituting about 99 per cent against 2,825 women of whom about 72 per cent were Saudis and 787 were expatriate women.

4,25,600 will be deported, according to economic analyst Abdelhamid al-Omari. This would mean that more than 3.5 million expatriates have left the Kingdom in only two years.

Replacing expats with Saudi nationals are expected to spike

hiring costs by 30 per cent.

The first phase aims to unlock 30,000 jobs for Saudi men and women, who would replace expatriates, according to the Ministry of Labour. The three phases aim at creating a total of 60,000 jobs.

## UAE amnesty: Amer centres issue over 25,000 new visas

THE General Directorate of Residency and Foreigners Affairs (GDRFA) in Dubai announced issuing over 25,000 new sponsor visas and renewing around 2,900 residencies during the ongoing amnesty.

As part of 'Protect Yourself by Modifying Your Status' initiative, which will end on October 31, the designated service centres (Amer centres) across Dubai finished over 32,843 transactions since the amnesty period started August 1.

Major General Mohammed Ahmed Al Marri, Director General of GDRFA, said among the transactions Amer centres finished involved 7,757 cases of residency violators. Since the amnesty started, Amer centres cancelled 2,344 visas, renewed 2,916 visas and issued 25,086 new sponsor visas.

Mr Al Marri said, Amer cen-



tres also received 165 applications from people of war-torn countries who were allowed to apply for a one-year residency with an exemption from overstays fines.

"We have equipped these centres with all the required services to ensure easy completion of transactions," he said. Amer

and Tasheel centres allowed job-seekers and overstaying residents to modify their status without facing legal action or hefty fines. Instead, applicants only paid Dh521 to modify their status.

"As long as they have no absconding records, they can modify their status if they have

a new sponsor or job offer," Mr Al Marri told the press. Jobseekers are allowed to apply for a six-month temporary visa.

He noted that the centres also cancelled visas for people who wanted to go home without paying overstaying fines.

There are currently 47 Amer centres across Dubai, of which 21 centres are in the densely populated areas of Bur Dubai and 26 are in Deira. "This spread allows customers to finish their transactions in the closest centre to them to save their time and effort," said Al Marri.

The one-stop shops finishes all visa-related transactions, entry permits and visit visas, issues or renews residency visa, visa cancellation and finishes Emirates ID services among other related government services provided by entities like Dubai Courts, Dubai Municipality and Department of Economic Development.

## Commercial ops in Kannur Airport to begin in a month

COMMERCIAL operations at the greenfield Kannur International Airport (KIAL), the fourth one in Kerala, will take off in a month or so with the landing trial of the passenger jet having successfully carried out. A Boeing 737/800 belonging to Air India Express landed at the airport as part of the trial landing of larger aircraft on September 10 after having hovered over the airport for nearly 45 minutes.

The flight that took off from Thiruvananthapuram airport flew over the airport as a proving flight for the Doppler Very

High-Frequency Omnidirectional Range (DVOR) approach procedure check. The aircraft landed following six approaches.

It also performed a docking trial, by docking with one of the passenger boarding bridges in the airport apron. After landing, the aircraft was accorded the ceremonial water salute by two fire-fighting vehicles at the airport when it entered the apron from the taxiway.

Thulasidas, Managing Director of Kannur International Airport which runs the airport said, this is part of the airport's approval process and in compliance with the stipulation of the Director General of Civil Aviation (DGCA). He said, one or two flight tri-

als were also required as part of the approval process and added that it was glad that Air India Express, a subsidiary of the national flight carrier Air India, was the first commercial aircraft to land in the airport.

Air India officials said, Air India Express would give a report of the landing of the big craft to DGCA and airport authorities soon. After receiving the report, the Director General of Civil Aviation would give the final commercial licence to the airport.

The KIAL board meeting scheduled to be held on September 29 in Thiruvananthapuram will announce the inauguration of the airport.

## God's Own Country shows its resilience, rolls out action plan to attract tourists

KERALA Tourism has rolled out a 12-point action plan to overcome the crisis facing the tourism sector due to the recent floods and to increase the footfall during the forthcoming peak tourist season.

The plan aims at increasing tourist arrivals to see the Ne-

lukurinji that has bloomed after 12 years in Munnar and in the peak season commencing October through aggressive marketing campaign within the country and in traditional and new markets abroad.

Top priority would be given to restore the national highway, state highway and other road corridors that connected tourist destinations with the help of the

public works department and local self-government institutions to make travel hassle-free for holidaymakers, said the Minister for Tourism, Kadkampally Surendran in Thiruvananthapuram.

Tourists have started coming to the state this month. But many are fearing to come down unaware that the monsoon fury is over. The plan is to convey the message that the state is

safe for travel and stay, said the minister.

Kerala will participate in all domestic and international travel trade fairs and marts to convey the message that God's Own Country has bounced back after the floods. A new campaign will be launched to promote destination and products.

The government will look into whether an IPL-model champions boat league can be organised. "Organising it will give a strong message to holidaymakers that the water bodies in the state are safe. A final decision will be taken after the Chief Minister, Pinarayi Vijayan's return from the US," he said.

The Kerala Travel Mart will be organised as scheduled from September 27 to 30 as it gives an opportunity to project the destination among 10,000 buyers and sellers. The state will also attend the prestigious World Travel market in London from November 5.

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**Action Vital**

It is a sad story. An estimated 6.3-million children under 15 years of age died in 2017, or 1 every 5 seconds, mostly of preventable causes, according to new mortality estimates released by UNICEF, the World Health Organization, the UN Population Division and the World Bank Group. The vast majority of these deaths – 5.4 million – occur in the first five years of life, with newborns accounting for around half of the deaths. "Without urgent action, 56-million children under 5 will die from now until 2030 – half of them newborns," says Laurence Chandy, UNICEF Director of Data, Research and Policy. "We have made remarkable progress to save children since 1990, but millions are still dying because of who they are and where they are born. With simple solutions like medicines, clean water, electricity and vaccines, we can change that reality for every child." Globally, in 2017, half of all deaths under 5 years of age took place in sub-Saharan Africa, and another 30 per cent in Southern Asia. In sub-Saharan Africa, 1 in 13 children died before their fifth birthday. In high-income countries, that number was 1 in 185. Most children under 5 die due to preventable or treatable causes such as complications during birth, pneumonia, diarrhoea, neonatal sepsis and malaria. By comparison, among children between 5 and 14 years of age, injuries become a more prominent cause of death, especially from drowning and road accidents. Within this age group, regional differences also exist, with the risk of dying for a child from sub-Saharan Africa 15-times higher than in Europe. For children everywhere, the most risky period of life is the first month. In 2017, 2.5-million newborns died in their first month. A baby born in sub-Saharan Africa or in Southern Asia was nine times more likely to die in the first month than a baby born in a high-income country. And progress towards saving newborns has been slower than for other children under 5 years of age since 1990. Even within countries, disparities persist. Under-5 mortality rates among children in rural areas are, on average, 50 per cent higher than among children in urban areas. In addition, those born to uneducated mothers are more than twice as likely to die before turning 5 than those born to mothers with a secondary or higher education. Despite these challenges, fewer children are dying each year worldwide. The number of children dying under 5 has fallen dramatically from 12.6 million in 1990 to 5.4 million in 2017. The number of deaths in older children aged between 5-14 years dropped from 1.7 million to under a million in the same period. "This new report highlights the remarkable progress since 1990 in reducing mortality among children and young adolescents," says Liu Zhenmin, UN Under-Secretary-General for Economic and Social Affairs. "Reducing inequality by assisting the most vulnerable newborns, children and mothers is essential for achieving the target of the Sustainable Development Goals on ending preventable childhood deaths and for ensuring that no one is left behind."

**D**URING her last visit to Delhi, West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee quoted a line from Rabindranath Tagore's song *Amra Sobai Raja* (all of us are kings) when asked who would be the proposed combined opposition's prime ministerial face to take on Narendra Modi in coming parliamentary elections.

Implicit in her escapist remark was a sharp division in the opposition camp on the issue. That division along with a sense of drift came to the fore, as BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) candidate coasted to a comfortable victory in the election held on August 9 to the post of Vice-Chairman of the Rajya Sabha, the upper house of parliament.

With its 73 lawmakers in the 244-member Rajya Sabha, the BJP did not have the numbers to win the election on its own strength and needed the support of its allies and key non-NDA regional parties. The NDA candidate not only secured more votes than the total numerical strength of BJP and its allies in the 244-member Rajya Sabha, the opposition nominee B K Hariprasad, who is a senior Congress party leader, failed to secure even the votes expected from a united opposition. It was for the first time in 26 years that balloting had to be held to choose the Rajya Sabha Deputy Chairman as against the usual practice of having a consensus.

The election was necessitated by the retirement of senior Congress leader P J Kurien on July 31 as the Vice-Chairman. By and large, the tradition in Indian parliamentary democracy has been that the posts of the Speaker of the Lok Sabha, the lower house of parliament, and the Rajya Sabha Chairman go to the ruling party and their deputies to the main opposition party.

But a BJP under Prime Minister Modi's leadership is a different proposition. It reflects the trust-deficit between the ruling party and the opposition and bitter and sharpening political competition ahead of a series of state elections later this year and national elections due early

next year.

A kind of 'no-quarters-given' approach has taken over. The Rajya Sabha Deputy Chairman poll clearly showed that Modi-led BJP has a killer instinct and would go all out to win any election including the one that could be largely for the optics and perception.

True, the result of the election to the post of Rajya Sabha Deputy Chairman is more sym-

This was the reason why the BJP invested considerable political capital with Modi and party chief Amit Shah reaching out to its restive and wary allies within the NDA and outside while the Congress President Rahul Gandhi not coming up to the mark in using to the hilt the existing anti-BJP forces.

The BJP achieved the dual political objectives in the election to the post of the Rajya Sabha

In the process, Kumar also made himself as a valuable ally to the BJP, as he was the one who spoke to the top leaders of key non-NDA parties like BJD and TRS whose lawmakers' votes turned out to be crucial and ensured the victory of Singh.

This was not the first time the BJD and the TRS came to the aid of the BJP. They did so by abstaining from voting in the no-confidence motion moved by opposition parties on July 20, an action which lowered the bar for the BJP to cross and win.

Had BJP put up its own man for the post of the Deputy Chairman of the Rajya Sabha, the BJD and the TRS would have had hesitation in supporting him or her. Besides, for both the BJD and the TRS, Congress is the main political rival in Odisha and Telangana, although the BJP is coming up fast to be the main challenger of the Congress and the BJD in Odisha.

The opposition game plan was scuppered by the BJD's decision to back the NDA nominee in the poll. In fact, when Sharad Pawar-led Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) leaders sought the BJD support for its candidate, the BJD chief Naveen Patnaik conveyed to them that his party has already committed support to the NDA nominee. That was the reason why NCP decided almost at the eleventh hour not to field its candidate, forcing Congress to deputy its candidate.

By endorsing an alliance partner's nominee for the post of the Rajya Sabha Deputy Chairman, the BJP signalled it is ready to not only assuage its smaller allies which of late had been upset about the domineering attitude of the lead party of the NDA and its brute majority, but also key parties outside the NDA-fold.

All coalition governments in India in the last three decades have been dependent on the life-and-blood support of smaller partners. But that was not the case with the Modi dispensation. In fact, the BJP's alliance-building had come in for questioning after another key regional outfit Telugu Desam Party (TDP) parted ways with the saffron party in April.

The BJP has realised that its position in large and politically key states of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar, which together elect 120 Lok Sabha members, is far from unassailable. Besides, Kumar had nursed a hurt that after joining the NDA, his party had not been given a single ministerial berth in the Modi ministry.

So, the Janata Dal (U) candidate for the post of Deputy Chairman of the Rajya Sabha was apparently meant to address the hurt feelings. Recently, Shah twice met Shiv Sena chief Uddhav Thackeray in spite of sharp attacks from the latter on Modi and the BJP.

While the BJP reached out to its allies and beyond, Gandhi faltered by not being proactive to galvanise the opposition camp for the Rajya Sabha Deputy Chairman election. Political analysts feel Gandhi should have called up Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) chief Arvind Kejriwal and sought the support of three members of his party in the Rajya Sabha.

The AAP lawmakers abstained from voting and Kejriwal said the party did it because there was no initiative from the Congress. So much for Gandhi's talk of willingness to move the Congress to the backseat for the sake of opposition unity if required and over parties that don't like the Congress like the TRS, the BJD and the YSR Congress.

India's political landscape in the run up to the 2019 elections has taken an interesting twist as is also evident from the fact that it would perhaps be one of those rare occasions when TDP, which rules Andhra Pradesh state, would have supported a Congress nominee. After all, the TDP's main political plank in the state is opposition to the Congress.

The People's Democratic Party in Jammu & Kashmir with which the BJP unceremoniously snapped its alliance recently leading to the fall of Mehbooba Mufti as chief minister, chose to abstain from voting and backing the opposition candidate for the election to the post of Rajya Sabha Deputy Chairman.

Deputy Chairman. First, it reached out to its Bihar state ally Janata Dal (U) and its top leader Nitish Kumar by fielding its candidate Harivansh Narayan Singh, former editor of a Hindi newspaper in Bihar; and second the saffron party knew Kumar's wider acceptability in the non-NDA camp would be able to pull in additional votes and prevent the possibility of their moving towards the opposition side.

That is why, Rajya Sabha lawmakers of key non-NDA regional parties like Biju Janata Dal (BJD) and Telangana Rashtra Samiti (TRS) voted for Singh decisively swinging the balance in favour of him.

Even Shiv Sena, the BJP's oldest ally which had been strongly critical of Modi and the BJP on a range of issues in the last one year and refused to back Modi in the July 20 no-trust vote, backed Singh.

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**Single tribunal  
for inter-state  
river water  
sharing disputes**

**T**HE Supreme Court vide its orders dated February 16 and May 18, 2018 has delivered final judgement in the Civil Appeals No 2453 of 2007, 2454 of 2007, 2456 of 2007 filed by states of Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Kerala against the award of Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal (CWDT) on the allocation of water to them, and the award of CWDT has now merged with the judgement of the Supreme Court dated February 16, 2018.

The Central government is satisfied that no further reference to the tribunal in the matter would be necessary. Therefore, the CWDT has been dissolved vide Notification No SO 3465(E) dated July 16, 2018. The Parliament has enacted Interstate River Water Disputes (IRWD) Act, 1956 for adjudication of disputes relating to waters of inter-state rivers and river valley thereof.

When any request under the said act is received from any state government in respect of any water dispute on the inter-state rivers and the Central government is of the opinion that the water dispute cannot be settled by negotiations, the Central government constitutes a WDT for the adjudication of the water dispute. Currently, five WDTs are active.

In order to further streamline the adjudication of inter-state river water disputes, the IRWD (Amendment) Bill, 2017 was introduced in Lok Sabha by the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation in March 2017 by amending the existing IRWD Act, 1956.

The Bill envisages constituting a standalone tribunal with permanent establishment and permanent office space and infrastructure so as to obviate with the need to set up a separate tribunal for each water dispute, which is invariably a time-consuming process.

In the Bill, there is a provision for establishment of a Dispute Resolution Committee by the Central government for resolving amicably, the inter-state water disputes within a maximum period of one-year-and-six months.

Any dispute, which cannot be settled by negotiations, shall be referred to the tribunal for its adjudication. The dispute so referred to the tribunal shall be assigned by the Chairperson of the tribunal to a Bench of the tribunal for adjudication.



The proposed amendments in the Bill will speed up the adjudication of water disputes referred to it. The Bill was referred to Parliamentary Standing Committee on Water Resources for examination.

The Standing Committee has submitted its recommendation on the Bill vide Lok Sabha Secretariat letter dated August 11, 2017 in the form of 'Nineteenth Report of Standing Committee on Water Resources on The IRWD (Amendment) Bill, 2017'. Accordingly, the ministry has prepared draft Cabinet Note for amending the existing IRWD (Amendment) Bill, 2017.

**Income-Tax returns filing up  
71 per cent till August 31, 2018**

**T**HERE has been a marked improvement in the number of Income Tax Returns (ITRs) filed during FY 2018 (up to August 31, 2018, the extended due date of filing) compared to the corresponding period in the preceding year. The total number of ITRs e-filed up to August 31, 2018 was 5.42 crore as against 3.17 crore up to August 31, 2017, marking an increase of 70.86 per cent. Almost 34.95 lakh returns were uploaded on August 31, 2018 itself, being the last date of the extended due date of filing of ITRs.

A remarkable increase is seen in the number of ITRs in two categories ie ITRs filed by salaried individuals (ITR-1&2) as also those availing the benefit of the Presumptive Taxation Scheme (ITR-4).

The total number of e>Returns of salaried individual taxpayers filed till August 31, 2018 increased to 3.37 crore from 2.19 crore returns filed during the corresponding period of 2017, registering

an increase of 1.18 crore returns translating into a growth of almost 54 per cent.

A stupendous growth has been witnessed in the number of returns e-Filed by persons availing the benefit of presump-

tion improvement in the level of voluntary compliance of taxpayers which can be attributed to several factors, including the impact of demonetisation, enhanced persuasion & education of taxpayers as also the impending provision



tive tax, with 1.17 crore returns having been filed up to August 31, 2018 compared to 14.93 lakh returns up to August 31, 2017 registering a massive increase of 681.69 per cent.

The increase in the number of returns reveals a marked im-

provement in the level of voluntary compliance of taxpayers which can be attributed to several factors, including the impact of demonetisation, enhanced persuasion & education of taxpayers as also the impending provision of late fee which would be effective on late filing of returns. This is indicative of an India moving steadily towards a more tax compliant society & reflects the impact of continuous leveraging of technology to improve taxpayer service delivery.

## 5 lakh community, 67 lakh individual household toilets to be constructed by 2019

THE civic bodies of the national capital will achieve their physical target of constructing 5 lakh community and 67 lakh individual household toilets by the end of 2019, said Hardeep Singh Puri, Union Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs.

While speaking at a workshop on 'Swachh Survekshan-2019' for the municipal bodies of the national capital city, in New Delhi, Mr Puri said, so far as the open defecation free (ODF) target was concerned, it required the behavioural change of the public at large in rural and urban areas of the country.

The behaviour change had many aspects like gender empowerment, dignity of girl child, and green and clean cities envisioned under the Swachh Bharat Mission. In addition to construction of toilets, more attention and efforts are required in respect of scientific processing

of solid waste management. The mission has now become a mass movement, said the minister.

The New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) has bagged the first position in the category of cities of one to three lakh population and overall fourth position in the country. Now the



Ministry of Housing and Urban Development hopes that it would get the overall first position in the forthcoming Swachh Survekshan-2019, added Mr Puri.

Under the Smart City initiatives, the NDMC had achieved many milestones by commissioning various projects like Wi-

Fi, Smart Poles, Solar Tree and Ideation Centre at Connaught Place. There is a need to reduce plastic items in day-to-day life, said Meenakashi Lekhi, Member of Parliament.

It is the need of the hour to come forward to reduce, reuse and recycle the plastic waste so as to make the planet environment friendly, she added.

Outlining the details of the steps undertaken by the ministry, the National Mission Director of the Swachh Bharat, V K Jindal informed that the entire nation would be ODF by the end of 2019. The scientific segregation of the waste, started in 73 cities in 2016, now has increased to 4,203 cities in 2018 and the entire country will be covered by 2019.

The workshop on 'Swachh Survekshan-2019', organised by the NDMC in collaboration with the ministry, was attended by delegates from all the three civic bodies and Delhi Cantonment Board.

WITH the passing away of Muthuvel Karuna-nidhi, the head of India's key regional political party Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK), the curtain has come down on more than half a century of the golden era of caste-based and social welfare-oriented Dravidian politics in the southern state of Tamil Nadu.

At the age of 94, Karunanidhi was the last charismatic icon of Dravidian politics after the death of his arch rival Jairam Jayalalithaa, the Tamil film star-turned-politician who headed All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (AIADMK) which now rules the state.

With their death, the brand of politics practised by them based on empowerment of lower castes, social welfare schemes through subsidies for the poorest and devolution of administrative power has entered an uncharted and uncertain territory.

This at a time when DMK and AIADMK are transitioning to a new set of leaders and Tamil Nadu is witnessing new political alignments with the Bharatiya Janata Party trying to get footprints in the state through alliance-formation. Besides, the situation which gave rise to and shaped Dravidian ideology has also undergone a change in the last 50 years.

Perhaps no regional satrap in India more than Karunanidhi has driven home the message more effectively that power politics is the art of the possible and that pragmatism cannot be held hostage to ideological moorings if circumstances demand so.

How else does one explain the tie-up the DMK had forged with the two major rival contenders for power at the national level – the Congress and the Bharatiya Janata Party whose ideologies were at variant with that of the Dravidian party?

Karunanidhi's critics have often called this sheer political opportunism. But it helped the DMK to emerge as a key player at the national level with both the Congress and the BJP securing the regional party's support to form coalition governments to rule India in return for not only ministerial berths for DMK leaders in the federal dispensation but also rewarding them with lucrative portfolios.

Neither the Congress nor the DMK hesitated for electoral alliance in 2004 general elections to return to form government at the Centre brushing under the carpet that a judicial commission probing the assassination of

former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi had pointed a needle of suspicion to the DMK and that the Congress had the DMK government dismissed on this issue.

Karunanidhi was unabashed about his espousal to the cause of a separate country of Sri Lanka's terror outfit Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE) because the Tamil pride was at the core of identity-based politics of his party.

operatives of politics at the state and national levels and blending the compulsions of sub-nationalism and nationalism – this was possibly the most important lesson left behind by both Karunanidhi and Jayalalithaa as their parties for a life without them.

As the DMK and the AIADMK look to fill the void created by the exit of their respective leaders, they face a few challenges. The first question that arises is: notwithstanding the rivalry

Jayalalithaa. So, will Stalin do a re-think on the complete concentration of powers to take decisions related to the DMK with the family, a practice deeply entrenched under Karunanidhi?

In the absence of his father, Stalin will no doubt get more political space but he has come on his own to try and ensure that the essence of Dravidian politics still holds relevance in Tamil Nadu. He has already indicated in 2016 that he will stick to the path shown by his father when he played the Tamil pride card in a bold bid to counter Jayalalithaa's freebies and developmental plank.

The DMK hopes that factional feud in the AIADMK post-Jayalalithaa and the anti-incumbency faced by the latter's government keeps Stalin in the run. However, there is one noticeable change Stalin has shown. Unlike the father who was a proclaimed atheist, the son has visited temples, mosques and churches in recent years, reflecting the changing times.

Both the DMK and the AIADMK will have to factor Dhinakaran's stunning victory in the R K Nagar assembly bypoll and his rising popularity. What might cause more headaches for the two parties is the entry of two ageing matinee idols of Tamil cinema Rajinikanth and Kamal Haasan into the state's political scene. Stalin knows the DMK is out of power in Tamil Nadu for seven years now having lost two successive state assembly elections and one more major setback could undermine the DMK and create space for fresh political alignments.

In the short term, Stalin faces the challenge of choosing the right alliance for parliamentary elections due early next year because fresh assembly polls in Tamil Nadu are still three years away.

Karunanidhi was a master strategist in striking the right electoral tie-ups, an area in which Stalin is untested as yet. Stalin knows if the DMK succeeds in getting a majority of the parliamentary seats in Tamil Nadu, his party will return once again as a crucial player at the national-level government formation particularly if the general elections produce a fractured mandate.

A setback will only undermine his leadership. Therefore, the Dravidian politics post-Karunanidhi and Jayalalithaa today finds itself at a cross-road.

THE scientists and researchers should regularly interact with farmers and work in a mission mode to double the farmers' income by 2022 as envisaged by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Doubling of farmers' income can be achieved through reduction in input cost, value addition and proper marketing of agricultural produce, said the Vice-President, Venkaiah Naidu.

While speaking at the 10<sup>th</sup> Convocation of Karnataka Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries Sciences University in Bidar, Karnataka, Mr Naidu said there is a need to focus on Blue Revolution. Fisheries must be encouraged and given priority along with agriculture and the dairy sector.

The authorities should make sincere efforts to ensure that the livestock farmers move from subsistence farming to a financially-viable livestock enterprise. The allied activities such as animal husbandry, dairy and poultry play a crucial role in improving the farmers' income, as they support the livelihood of farmers by providing supplementary income, said the Vice-President.

It is not just doubling the farmers' income by 2022, the major global challenge is to en-

sure food and nutritional security. There is a need to alleviate poverty in developing countries by producing more and safe food, especially of animal origin, against a shrinking animal genetic diversity and increased global trade. The livestock production in the developing world



should be more than double to meet the growing demand of meat and milk in these countries over the next 20 years, he added.

Animal husbandry provides employment and also manure for crops. There is evidence to show that farming households with some cattle head were able to withstand better the distress

caused by extreme weather conditions and cattle wealth is national wealth.

Referring to the proposal to establish Integrated Indigenous Cattle Centres or Gokul Grams in the breeding tracts of indigenous breeds, the Vice-President said that the Gokul Grams will

be self sustaining and will generate economic resources from the sale of A2 milk, organic manure, vermicompost and production of electricity from biogas for in-house consumption and sale of animal products.

The integrated farming system models should be demonstrated and popularised among farmers. The scientific community should adopt the 4Ts formula and integrate tradition, talent, technology and trade, said Mr Naidu.

Quoting Swami Vivekanand, the Vice-President said that "we want that education by which character is formed, strength of mind is increased, the intellect is expanded, and by which one can stand on one's own feet".

There is a need to reform and streamline our education system. The universities should make good use of technology and expand the knowledge to students through distance mode by using online courses. School dropouts and farmers can benefit from distance learning," he added.

"Unfortunately our education system is focussed not on the creation of knowledge, but on the mass production of an educated workforce. Universities must encourage culture of research and innovative thinking rather than focussing on exam-oriented method to become a knowledge-based economy. The students should play an active role in making livestock and fisheries sectors profitable through scientific approach and technological innovations," said Mr Naidu.

## Cabinet approves continuation of Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana

IN a major boost to pro-people and pro-poor initiatives, the Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi approved the continuation of National Mission for Financial Inclusion - Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) with the following changes:

The PMJDY to continue beyond August 14, 2018; existing overdraft (OD) limit of ₹ 5,000 to be raised to ₹ 10,000; there will not be any conditions attached for OD up to ₹ 2,000; age limit for availing OD facility to be revised from 18-60 years to 18-65 years.

Under the expanded coverage from 'every household to every adult', accidental insurance cover for new RuPay cardholders to be raised from ₹ 1 lakh to ₹ 2 lakh to new PMJDY accounts opened after August 28, 2018.

The continuation of the Mission would enable all adults/households of the country to have at least a basic bank account with access to other financial services, social security schemes and OD up to ₹ 10,000. It will, thus, bring them

into the mainstream of financial services and will facilitate transfer of benefits of various subsidy schemes of the government more efficiently.

So far, approximately 32.41-crore Jan Dhan accounts have been opened with more than ₹ 81,200 crore of deposit balance. Fifty-three per cent women Jan Dhan account holders and 59 per cent Jan Dhan accounts are in rural and semi-urban areas. More than 83 per cent operative Jan Dhan accounts (except states of Assam, Meghalaya, J&K) are Aadhaar seeded, with issuance of approximately 24.4-crore RuPay cards to these account holders.

More than 7.5-crore Jan Dhan accounts are receiving Direct Benefit Transfers (DBT). Banking correspondents (BCs) have been deployed in 1.26-lakh sub-service areas (rural areas), each catering to 1,000-1,500 households. Nearly 13.16-crore Aadhaar-enabled Payment System (AePS) transactions have taken place through BCs during July 2018.

More than 13-crore subscribers under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana with 19,436 claims, involving an

amount of ₹ 388.72 crore settled so far.

Similarly, 5.47-crore subscribers under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana with 1.10-lakh claims, involving an amount of ₹ 2,206.28 crore settled so far. More than 1.11-crore persons have subscribed for Atal Pension Yojana.

A pipeline has been created for the implementation of PMJDY through which Jan Dhan accounts and mobile banking have been linked to Aadhaar (JAM - Jan Dhan, Aadhaar and Mobile). This pipeline is not only facilitating savings, disbursement of credit, social security etc, but more importantly channelising direct benefits of various government schemes to poor people of the country through DBT.

It has been decided to continue the flagship financial inclusion programme (PMJDY), with focus on opening accounts from 'every household to every adult'. The pipeline of JAM will continue to provide the necessary backbone for coverage of these activities, and thereby accelerate the pace of digitised, financially included & insured society.

INDIA is aiming big at expanding its footprints in strategically key projects abroad and take on competition from China, Japan, the US and Europe.

With this objective in mind, the Indian government has decided to further loosen its purse strings.

India's financial muscle has so far been seen as much weaker than that of China, Japan, the US and Europe. But on August 1, the Indian Cabinet presided by Prime Minister Narendra Modi approved the

The Indian government provides counter guarantee and interest equalisation support of 2 per cent to the EXIM Bank to offer concessional finance to any foreign government or foreign state-owned or controlled entity if any Indian firm succeeds in getting a contract for the execution of a project.

Under the scheme, the EXIM Bank extends credit at a rate not exceeding London Inter-bank

consumer goods in that continent to \$160 billion by 2025, as per McKinsey & Co. India is also seeking investing in strategic assets like airports, deep sea ports and naval facility in Sri Lanka, Bangladesh and Seychelles.

However, it is not merely the quantum of money Indian entities invest abroad that matters. What equally matters is the quality of the products and the timeline of delivery. This is an area where the performance of Indian entities has been far from satisfactory, as one often hears complaints of time and cost over-run. But

India also enjoys an advantage over China. In that the Indian concessional financial credit does not lead the beneficiary country into a trap of unsustainable debt trap, which is an area of serious concern.

Secondly, India allows the recipient country to choose its projects and implement them at a pace comfortable for it. Thirdly, there is no Indian assistance into the potential local job opportunities created by the projects, unlike in the case of China which has sparked resentment in some African countries and Myanmar.

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# ASSIGNMENTS ABROAD TIMES

**T**HE Jakarta-Palembang Asian Games 2018 in Indonesia saw India coming out with its best performance in the continental games. India achieved its best-ever medal tally at the Asian Games and equalled its highest gold medals haul.

World sports powerhouse China topped the medals table for the tenth time on the trot with yet another staggering haul. China won 289 medals (132 gold, 92 silver and 65 bronze).

India won 69 medals – 15 gold, 24 silver and 30 bronze medals – to finish at eighth. The Indian athletes in the track and field events were the cynosure of all eyes bagging an unprecedented 19 medals including seven gold. The performance in athletics was noteworthy as this was one discipline where not much was expected from the Indian athletes.

Swapna Barman's was undoubtedly one of the most inspiring stories at the Games. Daughter of a rickshaw puller, the 12-toed Jalpaiguri woman battled a severe tooth infection and became India's first heptathlete to win an Asia gold.

The final two gold medals came on the penultimate day. Amit Panghal displayed a soldier's grit to stun the reigning Olympic champion Hasanboy Dusmatov for India's only boxing gold while two 50-plus bridge players Pranab Bardhan and Shibnath Sarkar proved that age is just a number with their top finishes.

Hockey, kabaddi and weightlifting were a big disappointment for India. The men's hockey team beat arch rivals Pakistan 2-1 to bring back home a consolation bronze medal while the women's team bagged a silver. Veteran wrestler and two-time Olympic medalist Sushil Kumar too suffered a

stunning 3-5 loss in the first qualification round bout against Bahrain's Adam Batirov in the men's 74 kg category. His form was in question and his exemption from the trials was not appreciated by some quarters in the country's wrestling circle.

Indian weightlifters drew a blank. Now the time is very crucial. Mere celebrations and adulation won't do any good. Sports authorities should help in building on the Asiad performances with an eye at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games.

Former shuttler Susi Susanti, who won the women's singles gold for Indonesia at the 1992 Barcelona Olympics, lit the cauldron which marked the opening of the Games amid the trademark fireworks.

Chinese wushu athlete Sun Peiyuan won the first gold medal of the Games in the men's changquan category of the Chinese martial art. This edition of the Games featured 40 sports and saw the participation of 17,000 athletes.

International Olympic Committee (IOC) Chief, Thomas Bach praised Indonesia for hosting a successful Asian Games 2018 and said the country had the right ingredients to stage the Olympics. President of Indonesia, Joko Widodo made a surprise announcement of the 2032 Olympics bid.

"With the success of this Asian Games, Indonesia has laid a very solid foundation for such a candidature," Bach said, adding

"You can see the ingredients are there, you see a young, enthusiastic nation. Passionate about sports, working with high efficiency in the organisation...so, I think it will be a very strong candidature."


