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Business confidence rising in UAE

The global economic recovery that started in late 2016 is starting to slow down and lose momentum, with global confidence in second quarter dipping from its first quarter high. Despite this, across the Middle East and in the UAE, confidence rebounded further in the second quarter of the year and is now at its highest level since second quarter 2015

ECONOMIC confidence in the UAE and other Middle East countries rebounded to its highest level since the second quarter of 2015 in sharp contrast to a decline in global confidence level in the same quarter this year, according to a survey.

The key factor behind the recovery in confidence in the UAE and the larger region from the second quarter of 2018 is the sharp rise in the oil price, which peaked at \$80 per barrel in late May, compared with a low of \$35 per barrel at the start of 2016.

"This has resulted in an increase in revenues coupled with the introduction of Value Added Tax (VAT) in the UAE and Saudi Arabia, which has led to an ease in fiscal austerity," said the Global Economic Conditions survey released by the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) and Institute of Management Accountants (IMA).

"The global economic recovery that started in late 2016 is starting to slow down and lose momentum, with global confidence in second quarter dipping from its first quarter high. Despite this, across the Middle East and in the UAE, confidence rebounded further in the second quarter of the year and is now at its highest level since second quarter 2015," the report said.



Analysts at the ACCA said, although it remains high by recent standards, the slight fall in confidence reflects increasing fears of a trade war between the US and China. "This continues to effect global outlook, with

China's economic sentiment falling sharply."

Lindsay Degouve de Nuncques, head of ACCA Middle East, said, the economic outlook across the Middle East and the UAE would continue to be driven mostly by the oil price and changes in fiscal policy.

"The recent Opec deal, which was agreed in late June and saw member countries agree to raise production, is likely to depress prices over the coming months. However, with VAT being introduced across the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) (with the UAE and Saudi

Arabia live), it will relieve the pressure that was once felt prior to this fiscal policy being introduced, which will continue to provide economic relief and reduce further oil price dependency on economic growth," said Ms de Nuncques.

"It's good to see the improvement in confidence across the Middle East region, and while oil prices are a key factor behind this, expenditure for the 2020 World Expo in Dubai has also helped, along with an easing of austerity, but this diverse region is not immune from global economic shocks and therefore it is advisable that businesses should not be complacent," she said.

Hanadi Khalife, Director of Middle East and Africa (MEA) and India operations at the IMA, said the results of the survey show increasing business confidence in the Middle East which has been stimulated by continued investments made across a number of key industries.

"This falls in line with the objectives set by governments to achieve long-term regional plans such as UAE Vision 2021 and Saudi Vision 2030. The report shows that government spending is at a multi-year high and this is particularly focussed on diversifying regional economies and driving sustainable economic development."

Demand for WB financing in MENA rises to \$6.3 bn

THE World Bank (WB) responded to strong demand from countries in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region for development finance, global expertise and innovation during the financial year that ended on June 30, 2018. In addition to \$6.3 billion in new financial commitments during the past financial year, the Bank also delivered a wide range of analytical products to help MENA countries transform their economies, and lay the founda-

tions for inclusive growth and job creation.

The record commitment included \$5.9 billion from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, which supports development in middle-income countries, and \$430 million from the International Development Association, the Bank's fund for the world's poorest countries. The WB's knowledge services included support for the region's high-income countries through its Reimbursable Advisory Services.

The programme, which reached \$55 million during the past financial year, supported efforts to diversify economies and promote private sector development, while supporting human development through the reform of key public services such as education, health and social protection.

"We are committed to helping the region overcome its challenges and reach its full potential, and our investments match that commitment," said Ferid Belhaj, WB Vice-President for the MENA. "Going forward, we will focus on

the region's young people, with a particular focus on developing their capacity to harness the power of new technologies and create a dynamic and innovative private sector that can become a new source of growth and jobs."

The WB strategy for the MENA aims at fostering peace and stability by rebuilding trust between citizens and their governments, promoting greater regional co-operation, strengthening the capacity to cope with the impacts of instability, and supporting recovery and reconstruction wherever possible.

Guided by this strategy, Bank engagement over the past financial year included \$500 million in support of public education reforms in Egypt, a \$200-million project in Morocco to link farmers with markets, a \$225-million project to expand public transportation for the benefit of both Syrian refugees and the communities hosting them in Lebanon, and an additional \$400 million for an emergency project in Iraq to rebuild infrastructure and restore services in areas liberated from Daesh.

The WB currently has a portfolio totalling \$17 billion in the MENA region.

Global sanitation meet

THE Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation will organise a global sanitation convention to mark the beginning of the 150th birth anniversary celebrations of Mahatma Gandhi, also coinciding with the fourth anniversary of the launch of Swachh Bharat Mission.

Mahatma Gandhi International Sanitation Convention will be a four-day international conference that will bring together sanitation ministers and other leaders in WASH (water, sani-

tation and hygiene) from around the world.

A host of national and international dignitaries are slated to attend the event, for which preparations are underway. The convention will culminate on October 2 on Gandhi Jayanti day, which is also celebrated as the Swachh Bharat Diwas. Several mass mobilisation events and campaigns are being planned across the states in the run-up to the day.

India aims at eliminating open defecation by October 2, 2019, the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, who held san-

itation very close to his heart.

Rural sanitation coverage has made ground-breaking progress, from 39 per cent in October 2014, at the start of Swachh Bharat Mission, to over 92 per cent today, with behaviour change being the key focus of implementation.

The success of the Swachh Bharat Mission will undoubtedly have a significant impact on the global achievement of Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 6.2), i.e. to achieve access to adequate and equitable sanitation and hygiene for all.

Dubai Duty Free H1 sales jump 10% to \$1 bn

DUBAI Duty Free has reported a 10 per cent increase in sales for the first half of the year with turnover reaching Dhs 3.67 billion (\$1 billion). The first half figures

place the airport retailer well on track to reach \$2-billion sales by year end.

Liquor, perfumes and tobacco retained the top three category positions with liquor showing a 7 per cent increase year-to-date amounting to Dhs 553.14

million. Tobacco sales increased by 36 per cent over last year, while other notable increases in sales were seen in cosmetics (27 per cent) and electronics (25 per cent).


For the first six months, Dubai Duty Free recorded 1,27,69,905

individual sales transactions with average daily sales of Dhs 20.28 million.

Colm McLoughlin, Executive Vice-Chairman and CEO of Dubai Duty Free said, "2018 has been a fantastic year for Dubai Duty Free so far. We have continuously grown our business and are happy to see a double-digit increase for the first half".

"With new retail areas now operational and ongoing retail developments coming on stream at both Dubai International and Al Maktoum International, we are confident that we will reach the \$2-billion mark at the end of December," he added.

Recruitment at Dubai Duty Free continued in the second quarter of 2018 bringing the level of employees to 6,070.





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
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Digital Jobs

DIGITAL jobs can bring new employment opportunities for young women in developing countries, says a new report by the Solutions for Youth Employment (S4YE) coalition. The report, incorporates insights drawn from 19 case studies and lays out how jobs in the digital economy can increase young women's productivity, earnings, and financial independence. Globally, the share of women using the internet is 12 per cent lower than that of men. Over 1.2 billion women in low and middle-income countries do not use mobile internet, and women in these countries are 10 per cent less likely to own mobile phones than men. Digital jobs can help reduce longstanding occupational segregation, including in the IT sector. Working in the digital economy offers young women the flexibility to overcome mobility constraints and combat restrictive gender norms. Currently, women account for only 38 per cent of human capital wealth world-wide, compared to 62 per cent for men. It is also estimated that \$160 trillion in wealth is lost due to gender inequality in earnings. With unemployment rates for youth reported over 300 per cent higher than those for adults, young women are at a higher risk of exclusion, according to the report. While digital technology continues to create new forms of work, the absence of appropriate policies will prevent it from being fully inclusive. The report examines public and private sector initiatives that aim to close the gender gap in the digital economy. To empower women, governments can ensure women's online rights are protected, promoting gender-inclusive digital skills in the education system, provide and subsidise equitable access to information and communications technology systems and run public initiatives to close the gender divide in the digital world. The private sector can implement more inclusive policies to address gender bias in the workspace as well as promote gender equity in supply chains. "Digital jobs offer a unique opportunity for young men and women to overcome social, economic and political constraints to their participation in the workforce," says Mamadou Biteye, Chair of S4YE's Board of Directors and Managing Director for Africa at The Rockefeller Foundation. The report also provides operational recommendations in designing and implementing gender-inclusive interventions for young women seeking to enter the digital economy. It presents a newly developed typology which identifies the public sector, private sector, online outsourcing, and digital platforms that improve livelihoods, as the four drivers of demand for digital jobs. This typology can be used to map the degree to which digital jobs are accessible to different subgroups of youth and aims to help policy makers in making investment decisions on local initiatives that support virtual freelancing or digital start-ups, creating more employment and entrepreneurship opportunities for young women.

THE current position of organic farming with respect to area covered across the country is 23.02 lakh hectares (ha) under the schemes Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY), Mission Organic Value Chain Development for North Eastern Region (MOVCD-NER) and National Programme of Organic Production (NPOP). Under PKVY and MOVCD-NER schemes enough assistance is provided to Farmer Producer Companies (FPCs)/entrepreneurs for development of value chains/marketing of organic produce, said the Union Minister of State for Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Parshottam Rupala.

Cost of organic agriculture largely depends on on-farm generation of inputs. When on-farm organic inputs are used, cost of production per unit area is less by 13 per cent under organic agriculture than inorganic management.

However, if organic inputs from outside the farm are purchased and utilised, the cost of production increases by about 15-20 per cent depending on the nature of inputs used. Integrated Organic Farming System (IOFS) models being developed under National Project on Organic Farming (NPOF) promises to meet 70-80 per cent of organic inputs within the farm thus reducing the market input cost considerably.

During the conversion period of initial two to three years, yield levels are expected to be low till soil system regains to respond to organic production system especially in the intensive agriculture areas, said Mr Rupala.

Government of India under the schemes – PKVY & MOVCD-NER is supporting the production and marketing of organic produce in the country to reduce their costs and prices. Use of organic inputs like Phosphate Rich Organic Manure (PROM), vermicompost, organic/bio-fertilizers, city compost, waste decomposer have been promoted under these schemes which will further reduce the costs of production in organic farming.

Under the following schemes, policy measures are taken by the government to develop/boost marketing of certified organic produce easily available to household consumers to promote organic farming:

PKVY – Financial assistance is given for direct marketing to the groups and clusters including procuring common packing ma-

tions (FPOs)/FPCs for creation, collection and aggregation of post-harvest process centre (one between every 5-10 groups) at ₹ 20 lakh/cluster of 1,000 ha each.

Market linkage/brand building with FPO/Small Medium Enterprises (SME) including the cost of organic fare to be provided on submission of appropriate

terial, printing of packing material, brochures, leaflets, preparation of labels, holograms, transportation expenses to local markets, hiring spaces on rent for specific organic markets and branding of organic products at ₹ 15 lakh/cluster of 1,000 hectare each.

Clusters can develop their own post-harvest, value addition and processing facilities, preferably under their institutions such as Farmer Producer Organisa-

proposal to the Executive Committee (EC) on case-to-case basis at ₹ 53 lakh/cluster of 1,000 ha each.

Mission organic value chain development for NE – Financial assistance is given for setting up the following: Functional infrastructure for collection, aggregation, grading units and North Eastern (NE) organic bazaar at ₹ 15 lakh (75 per cent subsidy).

Integrated processing units

with total financial outlay (TFO) of ₹ 800 lakh or more limited to 75 per cent to FPCs and 50 per cent to private entrepreneurs as credit linked backended subsidy.

Integrated pack house with 75 per cent subsidy to FPCs on TFO of ₹ 50 lakh or more and 50 per cent to private entrepreneurs or maximum of ₹ 37.50 lakh whichever is less as credit linked backended subsidy. Transportation/four wheeler up to TFO of ₹ 12 lakh (50 per cent). Refrigerated transport vehicle/pre-cooling/cold stores/ripening chambers up to TFO of ₹ 25 lakh (75 per cent subsidy to

assistance is ₹ 50,000 per ha, out of which 62 per cent i.e., ₹ 31,000 is given as incentives to a farmer for organic conversion, organic inputs, on farm inputs, production infrastructure, etc., shall be provided directly through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) during the conversion period of three years. The target of an area of around four lakh ha is proposed to be covered in three years which is double the area covered in last three years.

FPC and 50 per cent to private).

PKVY is the first comprehensive scheme launched as a Centrally Sponsored Programme (CSP) since 2015-16, which now has been revised for next three years. The scheme is implemented with a 90:10 (Government of India:state government) funding pattern in eight NE states and three hilly states of Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand, 100 per cent in Union territory and 60:40 funding pattern in remaining states of the country.

The new guidelines of the scheme has been uploaded in the website <www.agricoop.nic.in/guidelines/integrated-nutrient-management>. PKVY is implemented by the state government on per hectare basis for 500-1,000 hectare area in each cluster. A group of farmers having a total area of 20 hectare as far as possible in contiguous patch within a village.

The farmer within a group can avail benefit to a maximum of two ha., and the limit of as-

clusters. Under PKVY scheme, 2,37,820 hectares of land has been converted into organic farming land and 3,94,550 farmers have been benefited.

Realising the potential of organic farming in the North Eastern region of the country, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare has launched a Central Sector Scheme entitled 'Mission Organic Value Chain Development for North Eastern Region' for implementation in the states of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura, during 2015-16 to 2017-18.

The scheme aims at development of certified organic production in a value chain mode to link growers with consumers and to support the development of entire value chain starting from inputs, seeds, certification and creation of facilities for collection, aggregation, processing, marketing and brand building initiative. The scheme was approved with an outlay of ₹ 400 crore for three years.

GST revenue collection for August 2018 close to 94K

THE total gross Goods and Services Tax (GST) revenue collected in the month of August, 2018 is ₹ 93,960 crore, of which Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST) is ₹ 15,303 crore, State Goods and Services Tax (SGST) is ₹ 21,154 crore, Integrated Goods and Services Tax (IGST) is ₹ 49,876 crore (including ₹ 26,512 crore collected on imports) and cess is ₹ 7,628 crore (including ₹ 849 crore collected on imports).



The total number of GSTR 3B returns filed for the month of July up to August 31, 2018 is 67 lakh. This is slightly higher than 66 lakh returns of the month of June filed up to July 31, 2018. The last date of filing return of July, 2018 in the state of Kerala was extended up to October 5, 2018.

The total revenue earned by Central government and the state governments after settlement including provisional settlement of ₹ 12,000 crore in the month of August, 2018 is ₹ 36,963 crore

for CGST and ₹ 41,136 crore for SGST. For the bi-monthly period June-July, 2018, compensation of ₹ 14,930 crore has been released to the states. The revenues collected in August, 2018 of ₹ 93,960 crore is slightly lower than July, 2018 collection of ₹ 96,483 crore, and June, 2018 collection of ₹ 95,610 crore.

One of the main factors for the dip in tax revenues is probable postponement of sale of items for which tax rate was reduced by the Council as the decision to reduce the tax rate was taken in the meeting held on July 21, while the notification of the reduced rate came into effect only from July 27, 2018.

Since it would have taken some time for the market to pass on the benefit of reduced taxes, consumers would have postponed their decision to buy expecting the benefit. The actual impact of reduction of rate of taxes would be observed only from next month onwards as the rate reduction would have got affected only in last few days of the month.

Even past trend of indirect tax collection shows that while July collections are 8.2 per cent of the total annual collections, August collections are at a lower level of 7.7 per cent of the total annual collections. This is another reason for lower collections during the month of August as compared to that in July.

IMD begins work to install AWOS at Kannur Airport

THE Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) has commenced work to install the Automated Weather Observing System (AWOS) at Kannur International Airport, which is expected to begin commercial operation in a month or so, to ensure the safety and efficiency of aircraft operations.

The weather monitoring system is being installed by the IMD, Pune, with the support of the National Aerospace Laboratories (NAL), Bangalore, as per the guidelines of the International Civil Aviation Organization, at a cost of ₹ 3 crore in the fourth international airport of the state.

The facility is being set up at the air traffic control (ATC) tower and on the end of the Runway 25. Besides AWOS, the system has Runway Visual Range – Drishti, an indigenous-developed visibility measuring mechanism designed and fabricated by the NAL.

Instead of passing the information manually to the ATC and through them to the pilot, the IMD will send minute-wise weather update in the form of audio messages directly to the pilot.

Religious institutions to get GST refund on food items

AAT News Service

THE 'Seva Bhoj Yojna' is a Central-sector scheme, under which the Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST) and Central government's share of Integrated GST (IGST) paid by charitable religious institutions like temples, gurudwaras, dharmik ashrams, mosques, dargah, church, math, monasteries etc, on purchase of specific raw food items will be reimbursed to them as financial assistance by the Central government, said Mahesh Sharma, Union Minister of State for Culture.

The specific raw food items covered under the scheme are ghee, edible oil, sugar/burra/jaggery, rice, atta/maida/rava/flour and pulses. These charitable religious institutions should have been distributing free food in the form of *prasad/langar/bhandara* (community kitchen) to at least 5,000 persons in a calendar month for at least past three years, said Mr Sharma.

The proposed total budget outlay of the scheme for the financial years 2018-19 and 2019-20 is ₹ 150 crore and ₹ 175 crore, respectively.

As per the scheme guidelines, the charitable religious institutions applying for financial assistance under the scheme are required to produce alongwith other relevant documents, a certificate from District Magistrate indicating that the institution is involved in charitable religious activities and is distributing free food to public/devotees etc, since last three years on daily/monthly basis, added the minister.

In addition to this, they are also required to produce chartered accountant's certificate certifying that: the quantity, price and CGST, State GST/Union Territory GST and IGST paid on purchase of specified items during the claim period; the religious institution is involved in religious activities and specific items have been used only for distributing

free food to public/devotees etc, during the claim period; and the religious institution is using the specified raw food items only for distributing free food to public/devotees etc, during the claim period.

The scheme guidelines also provides for inspection and monitoring by the officials of the Ministry of Culture, District Collector/Deputy Commissioner and State (GST) Authorities.

The institutions/organisations are required to maintain separate account for assistance received under the scheme and this account can be inspected/audited by the officers of the ministry or any other agency designated by the ministry.

Further, in case of misuse of funds, the scheme guidelines provide for penalties such as blacklisting the organisations, recovering the assistance provided by ministry with penal interest apart from taking criminal action as per law, added the minister.

TRIFED makes record procurement and sale of tribal products in July

THE Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED) Made record procurement of tribal products worth ₹ 204.88 lakh in July 2018 and cumulative procurement of ₹ 769.36 lakh during the current financial year.

This is an increase of 864 per cent in July 2018 and 511 per cent during the current financial year in comparison to the procurement made in the corresponding period of the last financial year.

This has been achieved as a result of concerted efforts made by TRIFED for scaling up of retail marketing

activities. The purchases during July 2018 have been made from 149 tribal producers associated with 23,127 tribal families giving livelihood to approximately 64,755 tribal beneficiaries.

Similarly, record sale of ₹ 163.43 lakh was achieved in July 2018. Cumulative sale of ₹ 529.46 lakh was achieved during the current financial year. This is an increase of 200 per cent and 69.50 per cent for July and the current financial year, respectively in comparison to the sales made in the corresponding period of the last financial year.

THE global healthcare Business Process Outsourcing (BPO) market is expected to grow at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of about 10.7 per cent

Worldwide healthcare BPO market to touch \$189 bn by year-end



from \$113.2 billion in 2013 to \$188.9 billion by 2018, notes an ASSOCHAM-Ernst & Young (EY) joint study.

The pharmaceutical outsourcing segment has the largest share and accounted for close to 80 per cent (\$90.6 billion) of the healthcare BPO market in 2013, according to the study titled, 'Medical Process Outsourcing in India'.

The outsourcing in healthcare industry is on the rise especially in countries such as the US where the cost of healthcare is high, availability of manpower is low and healthcare reforms are introduced by Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act

(PPACA) to provide affordable medical insurance to low-to-middle income Americans.

US healthcare accounted for the largest share (73.8 per cent) of worldwide healthcare BPO market at \$83.5 billion in 2013. It is expected to grow at a

With capabilities of Indian BPO vendors growing day by day, they now offer specialised services across different verticals, thereby enabling growth in targetted BPO services. The global sourcing (includes infor-

Primary and secondary sources estimate the overall size of healthcare outsourcing in India to be in the range of \$3.3-4.2 billion. Of this, around \$700-900 million would be the payer outsourcing market, \$100-200 million would be the provider market and \$2.5-3.1 billion would be the overall size of the pharmaceutical outsourcing market, notes the study.

India's mature pharmaceutical and medical education system is a key driver of growth, since more than 1,500 institutions in the country offer various medical and pharmaceutical

The most preferred destination for payer and provider outsourcing is India due to the various advantages such as high number of healthcare professionals available at affordable cost, a large patient pool and reduced time and costs for recruitment

mation technology (IT) and business process sourcing) market is estimated to be in the range of \$148-154 billion in 2014.

India's market share in global sourcing is estimated to be around 55 per cent (\$81.4-84.2 billion) in 2014. However, there are other emerging BPO destinations in Eastern Europe, Asia and Latin America. Out of all the delivery centres opened in 2014, an estimated 27 per cent (41 delivery centres) were in India, closely followed by Eastern Europe, rest of Asia and Latin America, notes the study.

Outsourcing in this industry is picking up well and India too stands to gain from the same.

courses. The quality of education, medical infrastructure and facilities are also good.

The overall market is estimated to be worth \$700-900 million in India with top BPO and IT vendors having presence in this segment. Claims processing and management continue to be the largest chunk of services provided, but slowly other niche services such as case management, utilisation management, disease management etc are moving to India as vendors start developing capabilities in these areas.

At present, we have ample reasons to pay glowing tributes to a humble creature. Let us raise a toast to fruit flies also known by the tongue-twisting scientific name *Drosophila Melanogaster*, for keeping their glorious, one-sided association with scientists for over 100 years. The journal *Science* published the first scientific paper on fruit fly research by Thomas Hunt Morgan in 1910.

Mr Morgan got Nobel Prize for revealing the role of chromosomes in heredity in 1933. He was then the head of the biology department, California Institute of Technology. Since 1933, the Nobel Foundation awarded five more Nobel Prizes to nine scientists for their epoch-making scientific work on fruit fly research.

The Foundation awarded the latest, the 2017 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine to three US scientists, Brandeis University scientists Jeffrey Hall and Michael Rosbash and Rockefeller University biologist Michael Young for their work on circadian rhythms. In 1984, Mr Hall and Mr Rosbash and, independently, Mr Young, found out that a gene period was necessary to maintain circadian rhythms in fruit flies.

On October 7, 2017, *The Guardian* newspaper listed thus the brief details on the Nobel Prize awarded to fruit fly scientists.

"Six Nobel prizes in physiology or medicine' have been awarded to a total of 10 scientists for their groundbreaking biological work based on fruit fly research:

"In 1933, Thomas Hunt Morgan used *drosophila* to uncover the role played by chromosomes in heredity. In 1946, Hermann Joseph Muller used X-ray irradiation to increase mutation rates in fruit flies. In 1995, Edward B Lewis, Christiane Nusslein-Volhard, and Eric F Wieschaus used *drosophila* to understand genetic control of embryonic development.

"In 2004, Richard Axel concentrated on odour receptors and the organisation of the olfactory system. In 2011, Jules A Hoffmann was given the award

for his research on the activation of innate immunity. In 2017, Jeffrey C Hall, Michael Rosbash and Michael W Young won the prize for uncovering the molecular mechanisms that control circadian rhythms." (Source: *drososchools*).

The scientists who worked on the life and behaviour of fruit

ing mechanism the researchers have discovered from a fruit fly study. He claims that an experiment at Stanford found that beers with fruitier base yeasts attract fruit flies. Humans also prefer such beers. According to him, a study done at the University of California, San Francisco found that the male fruit flies, which the females rejected, drank four times as much alcohol as the mated flies.

Many universities maintain fruit fly facilities. The Fly Facility in the University of Cambridge

Cambridge fly groups. The media room produces around 6,000 litres of fly food annually for Cambridge fly groups. The facility has a dedicated cage facility for large fly cultures and an isolation lab for working with quarantined stocks. Presently, the facility operates on a non-commercial cost-sharing basis. Fruit flies and scientists are made for each other. This association existed for over a hundred years so far. Chances are that it may continue for the next hundred years

AC charger consists of three outlets, charging three cars at the same time with the charging time from six to eight hours. DC charger consists of single outlet, charging one car at a time with the charging time of 1.5 hours.

As part of Swachh Bharat Mission and to continue with the Government of India's sustained effort to promote electric mobility

Charging Infrastructure Network for Electric Vehicles. Government has also funded solar based charging infrastructure for electric vehicles by BHEL. The DC 001 fast chargers have been supplied and commissioned by BHEL and the company is also in advanced stages of offering indigenously developed end-to-end e-Mobility solutions.

Dwarka, Sector 10, Delhi under Delhi Metro Rail Corporation; 2 DC chargers installed at Shram Shakti Bhawan, Delhi; 15 AC chargers installed at various sites under Jaipur Metro Railway Corporation (JMRC). Installation of 9 EV chargers (4 DC & 5 AC) & 2 EV chargers (1 DC & 1 AC) at various sites of South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) and BSES Rajdhani Power (BRPL), Delhi is under process.

Some technology projects including finalisation of specifications and draft standards of hybrid and electric vehicles (xEVs) by Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI), Pune; Development of Charging Infrastructure Management System by Indian Institute of Technology, Madras; Design & development of AC-DC combined public charging stations by ARAI; Development of indigenous chargers (AC/DC/solar) by Allgarh Muslim University are also being supported by the department.

Recognising the immediate need for reduction in pollution levels and for making cities cleaner and environment friendly, the government is working on Faster Adoption & Manufacturing of Hybrid and Electric Vehicles (FAME)-II scheme having focus on mass & shared public transportation based on electric power train. The necessity for development of charging infrastructure for smooth roll out of electric mobility in the country is being addressed in the phase-II of FAME scheme.

To reduce dependence on fossil fuel and for encouraging cleaner environment, the department has notified FAME India scheme in 2015 under National Electric Mobility Mission Plan of the government. The phase-1 of this scheme is being implemented through four focus areas namely demand creation, pilot projects, charging infrastructure and technology platform and R&D.

Under demand creation component of the scheme, incentive is available to xEVs in the form of an upfront reduced purchase price to enable wider adoption.

Beware of cyber warfare, equip police to combat threats: Vice-President

THE era of new age cyber warfare, and the new enemy can be combated only through the power of knowledge, said the Vice-President, M Venkaiah Naidu. He was addressing the 48th Foundation Day of Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPR&D), in New Delhi.

The Vice-President cautioned against cyber attacks by hackers working over the internet thousands of miles away and asked police to be equipped to handle attacks that jeopardise national security. He asked the BPR&D to evolve best practices, policies and procedures in policing to combat emerging new age na-

tional security threats.

"Knowledge and competence of our police forces and the ability to innovate, improvise and implement will be critical in strengthening national security. We need a Surakshit Bharat as much as a Samruddh Bharat and we cannot have a Surakshit Bharat without a Saksham Bharat," said Mr Naidu.

Indian government has taken various measures to prevent cyber attacks and stressed on the need to augment police response capacities. The set up for combating the new enemy in cyber space can no longer be housed within the walls of a seemingly secure single government agency.

The Vice-President called for

a reorientation of the existing paradigm and said that all security agencies must work in close co-ordination and also with the private sector manning to establish a foolproof ecosystem.

The government and private sector must establish joint mechanisms to protect the police a force against future challenges, including, the threats of modern warfare. All police forces of the country have to equip themselves with cyber forensic techniques and knowledge to counter a cyber attack or investigate a cyber crime, added the Vice-President.

The Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Kiren Rijiju and other dignitaries were also present on the occasion.

EMPHASISING that India is being globally lauded for its green initiatives and commitment to environment and climate change, the Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Harsh Vardhan, said Skill India is an endeavour by the government to act as a catalyst in bringing about a change by skilling, upskilling and reskilling technicians to bring down the emission of harmful greenhouse gases. Mr Harsh Vardhan said this while signing an MoU between the Ministries of Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship.

"Our nation is now being seen as a trailblazer in clean and green energy under the leadership of the Prime Minister, Narendra Modi. I feel privileged and honoured to be a part of the launch of this unique project and we must ensure its efficient implementation and monitoring," said Mr Harsh Vardhan.

The minister pointed out that even prior to the signing of the MoU, MoEF&CC has already launched a Green Skill Mission, adding that under the mission, within the next three years, training will be imparted to 5 lakh 86 thousand persons. Courses to provide skill development to scientists and technicians have also been drawn up in the Ministry of Science and Technology.

Harsh Vardhan quoted the example of Andhra Pradesh government, which has started the process of providing skill development in the leather industry to about 10,000 persons at a cost of ₹ 30 crore.

The Union Minister for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Dharmendra Pradhan, invited the leaders of the industry to invest in equal measure in the initiative to skill technicians.

"I urge the industry to make equal contribution towards training of such technicians so that we further strengthen our industries and our youth. The focus

on skill development should be as much as we have on research and production today," said Mr Pradhan.

Pointing out that the Prime Minister's attempt at enhancing the training facilities has been made a part of the skill ecosys-

tem, the minister stated that "this is great example of the ministries working together to make New India of our dreams". It is imperative that the two ministries work in close conjunction with the respective sector skill councils to identify the new age job roles which are relevant

to the market today. The minister also emphasised the need to map their demand and co-create a curriculum and pedagogy to ensure a robust skill training ecosystem and its outcome in terms of productive workforce that India will have.

The MoU was exchanged by joint secretaries in both the ministries – Gyanesh Bharti and Rajesh Aggarwal. The two ministries have agreed to jointly undertake upskilling and certification of 1,00,000 refrigeration and air-conditioning (RAC) service technicians on good serv-

ing practices and knowledge of alternative refrigerants to ozone-depleting chemicals. The project will be funded under the Skill India Mission – Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY). Mr Harsh Vardhan also launched a mobile application

for technicians. In addition, instructional videos were also launched on the occasion. The videos have been developed for the service technicians on various aspects of good servicing practices prepared in four regional languages and Hindi to have wider accessibility.

The videos have been jointly developed by the Ozone Cell and Energy Efficiency Services in collaboration with UN Environment.

It is estimated that at present, there are around 2,00,000 RAC service technicians in the country, with a large number of them being in the informal sector. Training of these technicians is an ongoing activity under the HCFC Phase-out Management Plan (HPMP) stage-I being implemented by Ozone Cell, MoEF&CC.


Under stage-I of HPMP, nearly 11,000 technicians were trained on good servicing practices and under stage-II, around 17,000 technicians will be trained. The skilling and certification of technicians under PMKVY will have twin benefits of significant environmental benefits and a positive influence on the livelihoods of technicians.

The project will also include train-the-trainer programmes, updating of National Occupational Standards and certification. The project will be implemented by the Electronic Sector Skill Council of India (ESSCI) and the Ozone Cell, MoEF&CC. It will be supported by industry and service sector associations for creating awareness and mobilisation of candidates. The project is expected to be completed within 16 months.

Since India is party to the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer, the country is in the process of phasing out Ozone Depleting Substances (ODS) and in the future, even non-ODS gases with high global warming potential will be phased down.


