HE UAE is ranked 17th globally in terms of competitiveness and it is followed by Saudi Arabia (30th), Kuwait (52) and Oman (62), according to the Arab World Competitiveness Report 2018. It was released by the World Bank Group in association with World Economic Forum.

Research by the World Economic Forum shows that by 2020 one in five jobs in the Arab world will require digital skills. Its report assessing the future of employment and skills requirements in the Middle East and North Africa region estimates 47 per cent of all work activity in the UAE faces increased automation.

The UAE, which leads the Arab region in terms of competitiveness, and is home to many tech firms, needs to increase efforts to expand the use of latest digital technologies to further enhance its dominance.



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Multi-Donor Fund

HE World Bank (WB) Group has launched the Partnership Fund for the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG Fund) in support of global efforts to meet the SDGs. The aim of the multi-donor Fund is to incentivise catalytic activities that strengthen SDG implementation, equipping countries with tools and best practices to achieve their sustainable development objectives ahead of 2030. "We saw a funding gap for high-impact strategic initiatives at the global, regional & national and local levels that could help to catalyse countries development trajectories for the SDGs," says WB Group Senior Vice-President Mahmoud Mohieldin. "The Fund will complement the Group's efforts at the country level and focus on cross-country capacity building, quality data, knowledge generation, and multi-stakeholder partnerships." Sweden is the first partner to help launch the Fund with an initial contribution of \$7 million. The idea of the Fund grew from initial collaborations between Sweden and the WB Group on SDG Financing and SDG Trajectories. Through these initiatives, a shared vision developed between Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida) and the Group that many more catalytic innovations could be developed through continued collaboration. The first 16 SDGs prioritise action on human, economic and environmental pillars as well as peace and security. SDG 17 is the primary focus of the Fund, with its strong commitment to the means of implementation. Goal 17 promises support through global partnerships and co-operation, finance, data, trade, capacity building and peer-to-peer collaboration. One of the first funding allocations will support a WB Group activity to develop new methods to enhance the welfare impact of private sector investments. The Knowledge Support to Welfare Analysis of Private Sector Interventions activity will help create and share analytical frameworks, tools and data to mainstream welfare and inclusive growth impacts in development operations in line with SDGs to End Poverty (SDG 1), Promote Sustained and Inclusive Growth (SDG 8) and Reduce Inequality (SDG 10). The Fund will also support the Refugee Investment and Matchmaking Platform, which aims at bringing local business, global corporations, foundations, philanthropic investors and the development community together to create opportunities for refugees and host populations. Supporting small and medium enterprises across refugee and host communities, the platform will enable a multi-stakeholder investment catalyst instrument, business-to-business matchmaking, end-skill building, and knowledge embodied in SDG 16. In response to the need for access to good quality data for the goals, the Fund will support the 2020 Vision for a data-driven exploration of SDG monitoring and implementation. The activity will develop a series of SDG datadriven case studies that help national, regional and global policymakers strengthen awareness of how individual SDGs are being measured, monitored and invested in.

Court struck down Section 377 of Indian Penal Code which criminalised homosexuality in India, a crucial legislation for ensuring equal rights to persons affected by HIV and AIDS in getting treatment, admission in educational institutions and jobs has come into force.

The Ministry of Health and the spread of HIV and AIDS and Family Welfare has announced implementation of the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS) act through a gazette notification. The act, which received presidential assent on April 20 last year, prohibits discrimination against such persons in accessing healthcare, getting jobs, renting accommodation, and in admission to public and private educational institu-

The move comes after the Delhi High Court asked the Centre why it has not yet notified the law to prevent discrimination against HIV and AIDS patients despite the statute receiving presidential assent in April last year. Hearing public interest litigation that sought immediate notification of the legislation, a bench of Chief Justice Rajendra Menon and Justice C Hari Shankar had asked the ministry "you make a law and are not notifying it. Why?" The matter was listed for hearing on November 26

"In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section 3 of section 1 of the HIV and AIDS (Prevention and Control) Act, 2017, the Central government hereby appoints the 10th day of September, 2018, as the date on which the provisions of the said act shall come into force," the notification read.

According to the provisions of the act, no HIV test, medical treatment or research will be conducted on a person without his informed consent and no person shall be compelled to disclose his HIV status for obtaining employment or services, except with his informed consent,

The legislation has provisions to safeguard the property rights of HIV positive people, he said, adding that every HIV-infected/af-

AYS after the Supreme fected person below the age of 18 years has the right to reside in a shared household and enjoy the facilities of the household.

The act also prohibits any individual from publishing information or advocating feelings of hatred against HIV positive persons and those living with them. It seeks to prevent and control

As per the act, Union and state governments shall take measures to prevent the spread of HIV or AIDS, provide antiretroviral therapy (ART) and infection management for persons with HIV or AIDS, and facilitate their access to welfare schemes, especially for women and children, among others.

A person between the age of 12-18 years who has sufficient maturity in understanding and managing the affairs of his HIV or AIDS-affected family shall be competent to act as a guardian of another sibling below 18 years

Cases relating to HIV positive persons shall be disposed of by the court on a priority basis. In any legal proceeding, if an HIV infected or affected person is a party, the court may pass orders that the proceedings be conducted (a) by suppressing the identity of the person; (b) in camera; and (c) to restrain any person from publishing information that discloses the identity

■ ORLD Food Day is a day of action dedicated to tackling global hunger. The theme of World Food Day 2018 is 'Our actions are our future – A zero hunger world by 2030 is possible'.

While speaking on the World Food Day, the Union Minister for Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, Radha Mohan Singh said that the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) takes action to remove the suffering from hunger and ensure food security and a nutritious diet for all. The focus of the Central government is that food is a basic need and fundamental human right.

Zero hunger could save the lives of 301 million a year, and can help build a safer, more prosperous world for everyone. The government aims at transforming India's agricultural sector to contribute to the achievements of global environmental objectives, and has launched a new project in association with Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), said the minister.

"The farmers are central to our efforts in food processing. We have a stated target of doubling farm incomes by 2022. Recently, the Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana, a nationallevel programme, was launched to create world-class food pro-

cessing infrastructure. This is expected to leverage investment of \$5 billion, benefit 2-million farmers and generate more than half-a-million jobs over the next two years," added the minister.

"Through Mega Food Parks, we aim to link agro-processing clusters with key production centres. This will offer immense value proposition in crops such as potato, pineapple, oranges and apples. Farmers groups are being encouraged to set up units in these parks, thereby reducing wastage and transportation costs, and creating new jobs," said Mr Singh.

"We plan to link villages through broadband connectivity, within a clear timeframe. We are digitising land records, and providing various services to the people on mobile platforms. The e-NAM, national agriculture emarket, is connecting agricultural markets nationwide, thereby giving farmers the benefit of competitive pricing, and freedom of choice." he said.

has allocated more than 30 per cent funds for women under various major schemes, programmes and development-related activities in order to bring women in the agriculture mainstream, said Radha Mohan Singh, Union Minister for Agriculture & Farm-

ers' Welfare. On the occasion of Mahila Kisan Diwas, the minister said about 18 per cent of the agricultural households in India is led by women. In addition to agriculture, women have been making exceptional contribution in horticulture, fisheries, animal husbandry, beekeeping etc.

A research by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) conducted in nine states shows that the participation of women is 75 per cent in the production of major crops, 79 per cent in horticulture, 51 per cent in post-harvest work and 95 per cent in animal husbandry and fisheries.

A National Gender Resource Centre in Agriculture, set up in the Department of Agriculture Cooperation & Farmers' Welfare (DAC&FW), has developed a women sensitisation module to bring about change in the mindset and behaviour of male programme operators.

In 2017-18, DAC&FW's MANAGE, EEI, SAMETI and other institutions have trained 5,645 people through 222 programmes. Besides, more than 98.14-lakh women farmers have been trained so far under the Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA) Scheme.

Special importance is being given to the role of women in HE Central government achieving the goal of doubling farmers' income by 2022. Keeping this in mind, the inter-ministerial committee formed under the chairmanship of Dr Dalwai has written a separate chapter on the empowerment of women to double the income of farmers.

> These efforts will certainly prove to be effective in enhancing the participation of women in agriculture. The Central Institute for Women in Agriculture, Bhubaneswar (Odisha), set up under the ICAR, has also been working in this direction. Co-operative education programmes of women are organised through state cooperative societies to ensure women's participation in various activities in the field of cooperatives.

NDIAN insurance industry is expected to grow to \$280 billion by FY 2020 with the government's flagship Ayushman Bharat-National Health Protection Mission (AB-NHPM) and other growth drivers like rising disposable incomes, presence of global players and easing of the regulatory regime, helping penetration of the insurance culture in the country, says a study by the country's leading industrial apex body Assocham and research firm APAS.

Overall insurance penetration in the country reached 3.7 per cent in 2017 from 2.71 per cent in 2001. Gross premium increased from ₹ 3.2 trillion (\$49 billion) in FY12 to reach close to ₹ 5 trillion (\$72 billion) in

Taking stock of the present state, the study says that the domestic life insurance industry registered 11 per cent year-onyear growth for new business premium in 2017-18 generating revenue of \$30 billion. The government has taken a number of initiatives to boost the insurance industry. The foreign direct investment (FDI) limit has been increased from 26 per cent to 49 per cent, while the regulator, Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority, has allowed insurers investments up to 10 per cent in additional tier-I bonds that are issued by banks to increase their tier-I capital.

S Argentina is the President of G-20 this year, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Argentina, Jorge Faurie and Minister for Production and Labour, Dante Sica jointly chaired the sessions. The overall objective of Argentine Presidency of G-20 is 'Building consensus for fair and sustainable development'.

Global trade and economic situation is at a critical stage due to the ongoing trade tensions, driven largely by protectionist and unilateral measures by some countries, said the Union Minister for Commerce and Industry, Suresh Prabhu.

He was speaking at the G-20 Trade Ministers Meeting (TMM) held at Mar del Plata in Argentina. The G-20 TMM was represented by ministers/viceministers of G-20 countries, eight guest countries and seven heads/deputy heads of international organisations such as WTO, ITC, OECD, World Bank, IMF, CAF and IADB.

The minister highlighted the need to collectively work towards enhancing confidence in international trade through dialogue and collaborations. Mr Prabhu underlined that as developing countries and LDCs suffer consequential collateral damage due to trade conflicts, resolution of differences through dialogue between the parties should be promoted.

He urged G-20 to change the narrative on trade by focusing on the potential of services for enhancing global trade,



keeping in view that services contribute more than 50 per cent to the world GDP.

Endorsing India's commitment to the rule-based multilateral trading system, Mr Prabhu called for collective action for revitalising WTO without undermining its core principles of special and differential treatment, consensus building, inclusiveness and transparency.

Speaking on the occasion, most members recalled the successful WTO Mini Ministerial meeting held in New Delhi in March 2018 as India's significant contribution to the revitalisation of WTO.

The ministers recognised the importance of Agro Food Global Value Chains for enhancing

global food security. Mr Prabhu pinpointed the relevance of keeping in focus realisation of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 2030 targets relating to removal of hunger, alleviation of poverty, empowerment of women and employment generation without losing sight of the plight of millions of small and marginal farmers in developing

countries and LDCs. He further drew attention to the need for tackling non-tariff barriers in the form of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures (SPS) that are more trade distorting than tariffs.

He urged G-20 to support transfer of technology, research, promote agriculture services and responsible investment in

agriculture businesses with an aim to encouraging greater value addition for MSMEs.

On the new industrial revolution, the ministers acknowledged the central role of digital technologies. Mr Prabhu drew attention to the need for minimising technology disruptions and promoting distributive gains for the collective good of all countries and, in this regard, he urged G-20 to work towards closing gaps in the digital divide within and across nations through capacity-building measures, technology adaptation and meaningful investments to give primacy to protection and promotion of domestic entrepreneurs in order to create jobs for millions of youth.

This would remain a challenge for an effective resolution within the proposed timeline. In the long run, effective implementation of the IBC will help in preserving the value of asset and faster resolution. That, in turn, means ARCs will be able to churn capital faster and enhance returns.

The access of ARCs to capital sources is also critical, because their collective net worth is just about ₹ 4,500 crore (CRISIL estimates, as on March 31, 2017), and they have a lim-

■ HE Central government notified the minimum environmental flows for River Ganga that has to be maintained at various locations on the river. Environmental flows are the acceptable flow regimes that are required to maintain a river in the desired environmental state or predetermined state.

Calling this a significant development, Union Minister for Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Nitin Gadkari said the notification of e-flow for the river would go a long way in ensuring its aviralta or continuous flow. Reiterating the government's commitment towards an aviral and Nirmal Ganga, the minister informed that the draft Ganga Act will soon be sent to the Cabinet for approval.

"This is a very significant moment. The discussions on notifying e flow of Ganga have been going on for a long time. We have taken this step to ensure a minimum amount of flow in the river," said Mr Gadkari.

The notification issued by the government will ensure that the river has at least the minimum required environmental flow of water even after the river flow gets diverted by projects and structures for purposes like irrigation, hydropower, domestic and industrial use etc. This is an important step taken towards maintaining the uninterrupted or aviral flow of the river.

The order will apply to the upper Ganga River Basin starting from originating glaciers and through respective confluences of its head tributaries finally meeting at Devprayag up to Haridwar and the main stem of River Ganga up to Unnao district of Uttar Pradesh.

Secondary Education (CBSE) affiliation bye-laws pletely revamped to ensure by the state during inspection ricular load is as per norms, as soon as applications are respeed, transparency, hassle-free procedures and ease of doing business with the CBSE, said Prakash Javadekar, Union Minister for Human Resources Development.

While interacting with media at press conference, the minister informed that earlier this year, the Board was asked to completely revisit its affiliation byelaws to make the system more robust and quality driven. The new bye-laws denote a major shift from the highly-complex procedures followed earlier, to a simplified system based on duplication of preventing processes.

CBSE is a national-level Board conducting examinations for classes X and XII. It affiliates schools across India and abroad upon fulfilment of various conditions as prescribed in its affiliation bye-laws. At present 20,783 schools are affiliated with the Board. The affiliation bye-laws in position were first made in 1988 and were last modified in 2012.

One of the salient features of the revised bye-laws rests on the fact that there is duplication of processes at CBSE and state government level. For issuing recognition under Right to Education (RTE) Act and NOC, the state education administration verifies various certificates to be obtained from local bodies, revenue department, co-operatives department etc.

The CBSE re-verifies them after applications are received. This is a very long-drawn process. Therefore, to prevent this duplication, schools will now be required to submit only 2 documents at the time of applying for affiliation, instead of 12-14 documents being submitted earvetted by the head of district education administration validating all aspects such as building safety, sanitation, land ownership

On complying with all these conditions, the school will submit an online commencement certificate latest by March 31 of the given year, based on which, the Board shall confirm affiliation of the school. Only then the schools shall be able to start new academic session under CBSE.

The new affiliation bye-laws also lay thrust on achieving academic excellence through mandatory teacher training. Even the principals and vice-principals of every school are expected to undergo two-days mandatory training on an annual basis.

A special category of innovative schools has been added to include specialised schools, not covered elsewhere in these bye-laws, who are implementing innovative ideas in the fields of skill development, sports, arts, sciences etc. Regarding fee, the provisions include full fee disclosure to be made and no hidden charges to be levied by schools in the garb of fees.

The bye-laws clearly state that fee is to be charged as per the regulation of the appropriate government and fee revision shall be subject to laws, regulations and directions of the appropriate government.

Also, for the first time, the bye-laws encourage schools to promote environmental conservation through harnessing solar energy, rainwater harvesting, greening of campus, recycling and segregation of waste, Swachhata on campus etc.

It maybe mentioned here that CBSE has 20,783 schools affiliated to it in India and 25 other countries, with over 1.9-crore
